Om (the Primordial Sound of the origin of the universe (Big-bang)

That (Brahman) is complete, or all-inclusive (Infinite)

Om Peace, Peace, Peace.

Mathematically, this is the definition of Infinity.



Origin of the Universe

- Brahman is the Infinite Energy Source
 - that existed before the Big Bang,
 that exists now as the Universe,

 - and that will exist after the Pralay.
- Origin of the Universe: **Infinite Energy transformed into Matter and**
 - Physical Energy = Heat, light, electricity, magnetism, gravity, electrons, protons, and
 - Spiritual Energy = love, devotion, compassion, intelligence and cosmic consciousness that pervades the universe

(Five Macro-elements)

Fundamental Reality of Creation

Source: Tattvabodhah (Translated by Swami Dayananda Saraswati, Arsha Vidya Gurukulam)

- Aspect of Brahman = Māyā or Prakriti (primordial energy)
- Prakriti created Space
- From Space Air (Gaseous comustible cloud)
- From Air Fire (with heat and light)
- From Fire Water (liquids)
- From Water Solid Earth, oceans, and life
- Conclusion: Panch Mahābhūta are Divine manifestation of Brahman
- At human level, Prana = Life & Prana is Air we breath
- By weight, the average human adult male is ~ 80% water

- If our lives are not based on this truth, then we shall perish." —Buddha.dāsa Bhikkhu





Vedic Environmental Ethic

- Mother Earth is sacred Goddess earth, Bhudevi
- All rivers are sacred: Yamunā, Gangā, Sarasvatī, Sindhu, Brahm-putra, and Narmadā, Krishnā, Kāverī rivers in South India
- Mountains: Kailāsh is abode of Lord Siva,
 - many places of pilgrimage (Tirtha),
 - abode of many saints, yogis, meditators
- Forests: Great significance of Forests in Vedic texts and traditions; abode of many saints, yogis, Gurus (teachers); Gurukula (schools); Vānprastha Ashram, ...
- Every book is sacred: an aspect of Saraswati




Universal Reciprocity

- We are a part of a highly organized cosmic order called Rta.
- There is a sense of obligation, a sense of reciprocity, that if you (humans) give back to Dévās (Sun, Moon, Earth, Rivers...) you will continue to get the blessings and bounties from Dévās.
- Devās are the Divine Entities whose cooperation makes life possible on planet earth.
- Examples: Grow a crop, make compost, put back in soil
- If you cut a tree, you plant a tree.
- If you clear a patch of forest to cultivate, you plant an equal size patch of land (that's not cultivable) with trees.
- The Chipko movement made famous by Chipko women's commitment to "hugging trees" in their community to protect trees from clear-cutting the forests by greedy interests
- The tree hugging idea also spread to Northwest USA to halt clear cutting of forests by greedy corporations.



Study of Nature

Many environmentalists, scientists and philosophers have been deeply influenced by the Vedic vision of Nature and Divinity.

Sacred Nature Conservancy

 - "Mother Earth provides enough to satisfy every man's needs, but not every man's greed." Mahatma Gandhi




Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam

How to Live in Harmony with nature


Americans make up only 5% of the global population but consume (use, abuse & waste) 25% of the earth's resources.

- Reduce consumption of things injurious to air, water, land Example: Use less power, water, paper, plastic, and harmful chemicals like fertilizers, pesticides, herbicide... Reduce size of lawn to half; plant trees in other half. Reduce playing golf; spend time in parks. Reduce driving, car-pool; turndown thermostat 2 degrees Maximize Use of Natural sources: solar panels, rain water
- REUSE Don't throw away products after one use Example: carry a reusable grocery bag.
- RECYCLE every thing that is recyclable.



Ahimsa Paramo Dharma

- Non-violence is the greatest Dharma
- It includes non-violence to any living being and to mother Earth and to the elements of nature: air, water,...
- Reduce Fertilizer/Herbicide/Pesticide use: Eat organic, locally grown, whole foods. That's good for Environment & good for health.



Ahimsa > Vegetarianism

- Reduce/eliminate Meat consumption
- Meat industry is the biggest polluter of environment
- Livestock production accounts for 18 percent of global greenhouse gas emissions, including 9 percent of carbon dioxide and 37 percent of methane gas emissions worldwide, according to the Livestock, Environment and Development (LEAD) Initiative
- Meat production is projected to double by 2020 due to increased per capita global consumption of meat and population growth.
- These trends will have major consequences on the global environment. Vast transfers of "virtual" energy, water and nutrients will occur among nations that will have large impacts on local and distant environments.
- Meat consumption leads to many diseases
- Plant food: good for environment & good for health.

Gaia = Greek godess Earth


- Greek mythology: Gaia = Greek godess Earth
